IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that each applicant for admission to the Bar of the Central District of California must pay to the Clerk the admission fee of \$181, as prescribed by the Judicial Conference of the United States, plus an additional fee that the Clerk will place to the credit of the Attorney Admission Fund. The total fee for admission to the Bar of this Court is therefore as follows:

Lawyers Admitted to the California Bar – Fewer than 3 Years: \$281 Lawyers Admitted to the California Bar – 3 or More Years: \$331

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that, unless exempted by this General Order, every attorney who has been a member of the Bar of the Central District of California for at least one year must pay an annual renewal fee of \$25. This annual renewal fee will be due on September 1 of each year for all attorneys admitted to the Court's Bar before September 1 of the prior year. Attorneys who fail to pay the fee by September 30 will be subject to removal from the rolls of the Court's Bar. Attorneys
 removed from the rolls of the Bar under this General Order must, in order to practice
 before this Court, reapply for membership under Local Rule 83-2.1.2.2 and pay the full
 fee for admission set forth above.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that each applicant for permission to appear *pro hac vice* in a case pending before this Court must pay to the Clerk a fee of \$500 per case, all of which the Clerk will place to the credit of the Attorney Admission Fund.

This General Order supersedes General Order No. 18-01 and shall take effect on September 1, 2020.
