GENERAL ORDER NO. 08-06

WHEREAS, the present eight-year term of full-time United States Magistrate Judge Stephen J. Hillman shall expire on July 15, 2008, and,

WHEREAS, the Regulations of the Judicial Conference of the United States Establishing Standards and Procedures for the Appointment of United States Magistrate Judges require that a Merit Selection Panel be established to review and recommend the reappointment of full-time magistrate judges; and

WHEREAS, on August 6, 2007, the Court duly appointed such Merit Selection Panel pursuant to Section 3.03 and Section 6.03 of said Judicial Conference Regulations, and in accordance with the authority conferred by 28 USC 631, et seq.; and,

WHEREAS, the Judges of the District Court accepted the recommendation of the Merit Selection Panel for full-time Magistrate Judge Stephen J. Hillman;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT Stephen J. Hillman is reappointed as full-time United States Magistrate Judge for the Central District of California, official duty station at Los Angeles, California for a term of eight years from the date of appointment.

The District Court Executive/Clerk of the Court shall cause certified copies of this order to be spread upon the records of this Court and shall forward a certified copy of this order to the Director of the Administrative Office of the United States Courts, as required by 28 U.S.C., Section 631(h).
