GENERAL ORDER NO. 269

Good cause appearing, therefore, subsection 2(a) and (b) of General Order No. 266 is hereby revised as follows:

- 2. The appeals the bankruptcy panel may hear under subsection 1 include:
- (a) appeals filed in the district court on or after July 10, 1984, the effective date of enactment of the Bankruptcy Admendments and Federal Judgeship Act of 1984 (the Act); and
- (b) appeals transferred from the bankruptcy appellate panel to the district court pursuant to section 115(b) of the Act.
