IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that General Order 310-A be amended as follows:

- "6. Related Case Rules; Transfer of Cases; Recusal; Disqualification
 - C. Upon the recusal of one Santa Ana judge, the case shall be returned to the Clerk for random assignment to another Santa Ana judge in accordance with General Order 224. If all Santa Ana judges are unable to accept the case for assignment due to self-recusals or disqualifications, the matter shall be randomly assigned to a Los Angeles judge from the Civil or Criminal Automated Case Assignment System, or otherwise.
 - D. Motions to disqualify a Santa Ana judge or magistrate judge shall be assigned as follows:
 - (i) Motions to disqualify a Santa Ana judge shall be referred to the Clerk for assignment to another Santa Ana judge in the same manner as cases assigned pursuant to General Order 224. If all Santa Ana judges are unable to accept the motion to disqualify due to self-recusals or disqualifications, the motion shall be randomly assigned to a Los Angeles judge. The judge to whom the motion to disqualify has been assigned shall determine the motion for no additional case credit.

10. <u>Trial Jurors</u>

Trial jurors shall be provided for the Santa Ana Court in accordance with the Plan of the United States District Court for the Central District of California for the Random Selection of Grand and Petit Jurors."
